

INKING WITH MARKERS TECHNIQUE

Supplies:

Stamp set: Seascape

Dies: Layering Circles

Cardstock: Basic White, Evening Evergreen

DSP: In Good Taste

Ink: Pale Papaya, Soft Succulent Evening Evergreen, Pool Party

Stampin' Write Markers: Calypso Coral, Soft Succulent, Evening Evergreen

Tools: Stampin' Cut & Emboss, Snips, Stampin' Trimmer, Take Your Pick

Embellishment: Linen Thread, Gilded Gems

Embossing Folder: Brick & Mortar 3D

Other: Window Sheet

1. Ink fish with Pale Papaya Ink pad. Use brush tip of Calypso Coral marker to add darker shading to rubber on bottom area of fish.



2. Breathe warm air onto the stamp to re-moisten ink and stamp image on cardstock.



3. Use Soft Succulent marker to color on left side of seaweed, and Evening Evergreen to color right side of seaweed. Be sure to use lighter colors first to keep from contaminating the lighter markers with darker colors.



4. Breathe warm air on stamp to moisten ink, and stamp seaweed image twice without reinking.



5. Color top of Thank You stamp with Soft Succulent marker and bottom with Evening Evergreen. Note: you can also color each word a separate color instead of the ombre look I did.



6. Finish card as desired. Here's my sample card.
